

HOW TO PURCHASE SHOWCASE TICKETS

Here's what you need to know:

Ticket Allotment: (2) tickets per student to each of the (3) showcase performances:

- SUN April 28, 2:00pm

Ticket Price: \$20 per ticket (your reserved tickets must be paid for)

DEADLINE: Reserved tickets must be purchased by APRIL 19TH.

• After this date, your tickets will be released.

Continuing Student Master Class Evaluation

WHAT: Each year Birder Studio offers a Continuing Student Placement Workshop.

WHEN: Tuesday, April 30th, 5:30 PM - 7:30 PM

WHO: This workshop is a MANDATORY workshop for any student currently in our Triple Threat Classes (Troupe A, B, C). It is ALSO FOR any student that is interested in being placed in a Troupe class for the 2024-25 season. Ages 7-18.

WHERE: Broadway Theatre, 123 S Broadway De Pere, WI 54115

DETAILS: We will evaluate practical technique and skills taught in our program.

TUITION: \$25

WHY: This workshop provides a personal evaluation for all students. The workshop formula includes that of a mock-audition which is rudimentary for all performers. It also aids the studio in creating a schedule that will provide the educational needs of our studio families and performers. No need for students to prepare anything.

HOW: Complete <u>registration form (sign up button)</u> and <u>questionnaire (scroll down to bottom of webpage)</u> online. You may pay via MindBody or in-person. You must be pre-registered. If you are not able to attend but wish to be considered, you MUST send your registration form in with the \$25 payment to be included in our placement process.
